Job Description:

The Area Mechanic follows recognized techniques and procedures of the trade, The Georgian Peaks Club's and The Area Managers policies & procedures. Exhibits strong, experienced trade skills and knowledge of Lift Operations at a ski resort is essential. Has experience with a wide range of situations, including the daily operations, seasonal shutdowns, and special capital projects. A thorough working knowledge of lift maintenance and ski hill operations with respect to the industry. Is able to work in a fast-paced environment keeping safety of the crew, and resort guests foremost.

Duties & Responsibilities:

- Works under the direction of the Area Manager and has the capabilities to fill in during the event of his/her absence if assigned.
- Ensure safety of guests and departmental staff through proper training and adherence to The Georgian Peaks Club's policies and procedures.
- Maintain an open and trustworthy relationship with respect to communication amongst staff and Management.
- Complies with applicable regulations, policies and procedures of The Georgian Peaks Club, Z-98 Code, TSSA, Lift Manufacturers, OHSA and departmental standards.
- Performs and directs lift maintenance personnel in completing routine mechanical maintenance and inspections up to The Georgian Peaks Club, Technical Safety Standards Association (TSSA), Lift manufacturer and insurance carrier standards.
- Maintain accurate & up to date records of all work completed on lifts and mobile equipment. Report on all departmental & mountain safety maintenance related activities. Expected to accomplish the departmental tasks, document them daily for the Area Manager, with minimal direct supervision.
- Training, directing, and scheduling department employees and apprentices in designing, installing, maintaining and inspecting mechanical systems used in passenger ropeways at The Georgian Peaks Club.
- To ensure that all vehicles and equipment are mechanically secure through preventative maintenance.
- Will be responsible for preventative and required departmental maintenance of all lifts, lift maintenance equipment and mobile equipment.
- Preparation of the fiscal year department budget, ordering and stocking of necessary replacement parts within budgetary boundaries.
- Train department employees to properly handle machinery for the purpose of reworking or remanufacturing parts
- Keep work & shop area safe and clean and report any damage, malfunction, misuse or abuse of any equipment or property at all times
- Wherever or whenever possible, assist other departments with general maintenance needs.

Qualifications:

Certified TSSA, SLM-A Inter-provincial certification.

Welding skills or certification an asset.

Working knowledge of hydraulics and machining.

Preferably 2-4 years experience in addition to trade ticket.

Previous ski resort experience including shutdowns and lift installation / infrastructure.

Strong knowledge in automotive, heavy equipment and/or small engines

Must hold a current, valid drivers license.

Must be flexible in work schedule, including nights.

Must be prepared to work in adverse conditions.

Skiing capabilities.
