**BASIC FUNCTION**

To assist teaching children participating in the Snow Bears, and Polar Bears through various camps and seasonal programs. Must be familiar with all aspects of the Alpine Program. All assistant Instructors must follow the Alpine Responsibility Code. Must be familiar with all ski conditions prior to the start of their day to ensure that their lessons can be carried out safely and without incident. It is recommended that all assistant Instructors obtain a Park Pass and be current with the safety aspects in the Terrain Park.

**MAJOR ACTIVITIES**

To assist teaching children in the Snowbear, and Polar Bear programs that are safe, exciting, fun and stimulating so that a combination of social and technical skills will evolve.

Attend weekly on-hill training sessions.

**RELATIONSHIPS**

Work closely with the lead instructor to address in a timely manner any concerns on needs of/parents.

**CRITICAL RESULTS**

1. Attend daily on-hill training sessions so that they are prepared to provide meaningful instruction to children in the Snowbear, and Polar Bear programs.
2. Help at all children's lunches and banquets.
3. Work with the lead Instructor to ensure that children are properly trained and looked after on bad weather days.
