

**Job Title:** Lift Attendant  
**Job Category:** Operations Department  
**Reporting:** Area Manager  
**Status:** Seasonal

Under the direction of the Lift Operator, Area Mechanic and/or the Area Manager, the Lift Attendant shall operate any assigned ski lift in accordance with standard operation procedures and area rules and regulations in addition to written and verbal instructions to provide safe, efficient and courteous lift service to The Georgian Peaks Club members and their guests.

**Duties & Responsibilities:**

- Lift Operators and or Area Management must be informed of any problems regarding lift safety, work related incidents, or any work or skiing related hazards. Ski Patrol personnel must also be kept informed of any problems regarding skier or employee safety or incidents.
- Area Management should be aware of any change in slope condition or work needed in line-up, loading and un-loading areas during and after operating hours.
- Ensure all work is conducted in such a manner that it is safe to do so.
- Team oriented with a desire to make a positive contribution to the resort as a whole.
- Highly motivated, works well independently with minimal supervision.
- Manual dexterity, ability to bend, lift and carry heavy objects, physically fit and able to lift, carry, and install lift lines, signage & other, shovel and rake snow
- to ensure safe, efficient and courteous operation of the lift that you are assigned.
- fully understand operating and emergency procedures for your lift.
- completion of daily logs and checks in a correct and thorough manner.
- inspection of lift line (while riding lift),
- a pre-operation visual check of lift line.
- maintain proper condition of loading and un-loading ramps, line-up areas, related lift buildings, and areas surrounding lift terminals.
- minimizing the number of stops, slow downs and missed carriers, while keeping safety standards high.
- checking of tickets/badges and reporting any problems
- discussion of any problems or difficulties with the Area Manager.
- Maintain a clean, neat, tidy and friendly appearance.
- if necessary, other duties as assigned.

**Qualifications:**

Knowledge in mechanics, machinery, electricity, skiing and resort operation would be an asset in this position.

**Work Environment:**

While performing the duties of this Job, the employee is constantly exposed to outside weather conditions. The employee is exposed to cold, wet and/or humid conditions; moving mechanical parts; high, precarious places and vibration. The noise level in the work environment is usually moderate. This is a Winter Resort Area. It requires that work venues are varied and in many cases include steep stairways, and outdoor work areas, subject to very cold, sometimes wet, or very sunny work sites. Some facilities are located at the base or bottom of the area and some are semi-remote and can only be reached by traveling via chairlift or snowmobile. Walking surfaces are frequently frozen, sloped and slippery. Proper footwear is a must, indoors and out. Work days and hours, as well as the number of hours required will vary.

**Essential Skills:**

Team oriented with a desire to make a positive contribution to the resort as a whole  
Able to interact well within a team atmosphere and to remain levelheaded in difficult situations.  
Good people skills are essential for this position, as well as maintaining alertness and being able to react to emergency situations while remaining calm and in control.  
Can lead by example and represent the resort to employees, various suppliers and industry partners in an ethical and professional manner.
