Job Description:

The Mechanic follows recognized techniques and procedures of the trade, The Georgian Peaks Club's policies & procedures and the Area Mechanic. Exhibits strong, experienced trade skills and knowledge of Lift Operations at a ski resort is essential. Has experience with a wide range of situations, including the daily operations, seasonal shutdowns, and special capital projects. A thorough working knowledge of lift maintenance and ski hill operations with respect to the industry is required. Is able to work in a fast-paced environment keeping safety of the crew, and resort guests foremost.

Duties & Responsibilities:

- Works under the direction of the Area Mechanic / Dept Supervisor and fills in during the event of his/her absence.
- Ensure safety of guests and staff through proper training and adherence to company policies and procedures
- Maintain an open and trustworthy relationship with respect to communication amongst staff and Management.
- Complies with applicable policies and procedures of The Georgian Peaks Club, The Z-98 Code, OHS and departmental standards.
- To ensure that all vehicles and equipment are mechanically secure through preventative maintenance.
- Maintain records of all work completed on lifts and mobile equipment and report on all Lift and mobile equipment maintenance related activities.
- Training, directing, and scheduling employees for passenger ropeway operation at The Georgian Peaks Club.
- Maintenance, personnel documentation, discipline and evaluation of employees.
- Complies with applicable policies and procedures of The Georgian Peaks Club, The Z-98 Code, OHS and departmental standards.
- Performs and directs lift maintenance personnel in completing routine mechanical maintenance and inspections up to The Georgian Peaks Club, Technical Safety Standards Association (TSSA), Lift manufacturer and insurance carrier standards.
- Supervises, hires, evaluates, disciplines and trains personnel within their section.
- Must be a good communicator and relate well to people. Will be able to plan ahead, set goals, and see that they are met. Will have excellent leadership experience and organization skills, and be able to bring the best out of staff. Will be able to cope under pressure, consider risks, review options, make clear decisions and act with appropriate resources.
- To ensure proper safety and cleanliness in the shops at all times.

Preferably 2-4 years experience in addition to trade ticket.

Previous ski resort experience including shutdowns and lift installation/infrastructure.

1 year supervisory experience.

Must hold a current, valid drivers license.

Must be flexible in work schedule including nights.

Must be prepared to work in adverse conditions.
