



Position – Freestyle Snowboard Coach

Georgian Peaks is looking for trained and enthusiastic snowboard coaches to work with freestyle athletes aged 7-16 in a positive manner and promoting a fun training environment. Reporting to the Program Director, this position supports the goals and development of the Club's athletes in training using the Long Term Athlete Development (LTAD) model as a guide. Georgian Peaks offers competitive wages, a great work environment to improve personal riding and coaching skills in a fun team environment while being able to snowboard on the best terrain in Southern Ontario. Positions are available in 9 week programs and Private lessons. Programs are nine weekends, starting Jan. 6. Additional opportunities are available during Christmas break and through the winter season.

Responsibilities include –

- On snow athlete development in the freestyle snowboard discipline; including free riding, Terrain Park and air bag venues
- Travel to local events and management of athletes in competition
- Communication with parents regarding athlete development, training and event schedules
- Administration of athlete participation, results and training plans
